Voting Rights

MMA dues-paying members are eligible to vote on ratifying the master contract, board member elections, and participate in surveys.

Annual Conference

MMA hosts an annual supervisor conference for 200 members. Attendees enjoy a motivational keynote, networking time plus breakout sessions and topics essential for supervisors.

Professional Development Program

MMA awards up to \$35,000 each year in grants to reimburse members for eligible professional development costs not otherwise covered by supervisors' agencies.

Scholarships

MMA competitive \$1500 scholarships are awarded annually to ten members or their dependents.
